
SHAPE OF THE RESONATORS IN FRONT, CENTRAL, AND BACK VOWELS



Each vowel requires a different position of both the tongue and the pharynx. Notice the differences in tongue and resonator space when singing [i] as in eat, [u] as in boot, and [a] as in golf.
